A father's response to his daughter's overdose death



After his 24-year-old daughter died of a heroin overdose, Damariscotta artist Peter Bruun needed to know everything about her tumultuous life. The result is *Elisif's Story*, offering an unvarnished look at her addiction through the voices of those who knew her best. This 36-minute audio collage delves straight into the confusion and pain that come when a loved one struggles with substances.
